Mayor McElroy called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. in the Town Hall Boardroom.

Manager Barth explained the Rich Cove Slide Agreement with the Emergency Watershed Protection Program.

Manager Barth explained that the Town of Maggie Valley would be responsible for Ghost Town's portion/ match (\$25,000) if they did not pay.

Council asked that Manager Barth meet with Attorney Dickson and draft a document for Ghost Town officials to sign stating that they will pay their share (\$25,000). Alderman Price questioned if the \$25,000 could be put along with taxes owed. Manager Barth will meet with Attorney Dickson to find their options.

The County Commissioners had no desire to assist with the clean up/ stabilization.

NCDOT will be under this contract as well.

The debris field will be cleaned to Landing Drive. The Emergency Watershed Protection Program is to remove the threat by removing both the new and old walls at Ghost Town. The program does not cover the damage done to homes.

McGill Associates will be the project manager.
