

**ORDINANCE 575**  
**TOWN OF MAGGIE VALLEY**  
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SIGN PORTION OF ORDINANCE 265**

**Whereas**, the following amendments shall apply to political signs listed under Article IV entitled signs not requiring a permit of the Zoning Ordinance 265

**Political Sign (Definition)** is a temporary sign of a candidate, party or group supporting the candidacy of an individual for office or expressing or soliciting public support of, or opposition to, any public issue(s).

1. Such signs shall not be located on within the public right-of-way or affixed to any improvement within such right-of-way (median, utility pole, traffic control device, bridge, guardrail, or other safety barrier), within a required sight distance triangle, or on Town property or buildings, except within specified proximity of polling places on Election Day, under rules established by the Haywood County Board of Elections.
2. Political Signs must be removed within ten (10) days after the primary, general or run-off election or referendum.
3. All political sign shall not exceed twelve (12) square feet in area. All such signs shall not exceed four (4) feet in height. All such signs may not be illuminated.
